Research what life was like in a Viking settlement in Britain. You could:

- Write a diary entry as a Viking settler.
- Compare their daily lives to yours. How has Britain changed in this time? Consider the culture and the landscape.

Write a Viking themed poem or story.

Write a fact file on Alfred the Great. Include pictures and information to describe their daily life.

Write your name and the names of 3 friends/family members in Viking runes.

Research the key events in the Viking History and create a timeline to show your findings.

Create a Viking themed board or card game. Write a set of instructions to go with your game then teach your family and friends how to play.

Visit a travel agents or research holidays to Scandinavia online. Design a leaflet to encourage tourism to the country. Include places of interest and places to stay.

Design and make a Viking Longship. You could use: boxes, cartons, tubes and other items you might find in your house or recycling. You might even want to create a paper mache model. You could then test how effectively your boat can float and sail.

Write a menu for a Viking feast. Find and make some Egyptian recipes to try during your feast.

Design and draw a piece of Viking jewellery or armour. Challenge: Can you create a prototype of your design using objects/junk found around your house.

Using the words 'The Vicious Vikings' Create an acrostic poem

Research the beliefs of the Vikings and create a fact file about what you have learnt.

Design a fact file/poster about a Viking longship.
