



After School Clubs Overview



We are pleased to confirm that our after school clubs for the Autumn Term have been confirmed. You will see that we are once again able to offer a range of clubs, many of which are continuing following their success in the last academic year. We hope you enjoy the selection of clubs on offer.

Some clubs are provided by external providers, all of whom have completed the safeguarding checks and requirements necessary for working with children in school.

Clubs are due to start the week commencing Monday 18th September 2023 and finish in the week commencing 4th December 2023 (11 weeks).

We do understand some parents may not wish to partake in the additional after school club activities. Of course, this continues to be entirely personal preference.

Bookings and payments for clubs provided by external providers will need to be booked direct through the provider. Details of how to book these clubs can be found on the club pages that follow.

Those wishing to book clubs provided by Sandy Hill staff or choir should do so through your ParentPay account.

Please note sporting fixtures will also take place throughout the year and children will be invited to represent the school at inter school tournaments and sporting fixtures, as has always been the case. Our aim continues to be that every child gets the opportunity to do this.



Last year we took part in the First Lego League Challenge, at RNAS Culdrose, against other schools in Cornwall.


Netball club for Year 5 & 6 will take place on a Monday and is a free of charge club.

Makaton club is available for all pupils in Years 1-6 inclusive and will be held on a Monday. There is no charge for this club. Children will immerse themselves into a world of signing and develop a repertoire of new skills.



Art club is available on Thursdays, with one club available for Years 1-3 and another for Years 4-6. There is a charge of £2.00 per week to cover the cost of materials used during the club. Payment should be made via ParentPay.



Gardening club will take place on a Thursday, for children in Years 1 - 4 and is a free of charge club. Please ensure your child has some old clothes, wellington boots and waterproof coat with them.



In addition to our extra curricular clubs offered this term, we will continue to operate our Sandy Hill Academy before and after school club.

Our Kids Club is available to all pupils aged from 4 to 11 years of age. The centre is run by qualified and experienced staff who plan and organise fun activities for your children. The children are supervised at all times by the staff, who have all been subject to a DBS check.
